There are some arms at this place,
also some ammunition, which will be of
great use to the militia, who are organized
at this point but are unarmed. I will be
obliged if you will direct the Officer here
to deliver to Col Lee, or to Col Shugler who
represents me here. My letters to you will
inform you that all the arms of the State
have been given out to the Confederate Troops
or were lost at Columbia. The arms here
are repaired generally out of order but
they will be repaired.
