Dear Sir

I appreciate highly the note with which your Excellency has favored me, as well as the kindness with which you received me personally. I hope you will not think me im-
-portunate now in requesting, as your Excellency has been detained in Charleston, that the Exemption if possible, be sent to us here. My son's furlough expires yesterday, so that he must return forthwith to Camp, unless he receives the Exemption.

The name is, Irvine Keith Heyward, & the application was to permit him to act as Police-
-man over 300 negroes, who soon will be without any white man on the Plantation.
