arine a slave of the said David Lipscomb did on
the night of the 26th Instant in the District aforesaid
wilfully, maliciously and feloniously set fire to &
burn his stables with four head of horses & a quantity
of fodder & shucks

To any lawful officer or W. A. Lipscomb of said District
Whereas complaint on oath has been made to me
by David Lipscomb that he has just reason to believe
and does verily believe that Catharine a slave of the
said David Lipscomb did on the night of the 26th
Inst. in the District aforesaid wilfully, maliciously
& feloniously set fire to & burn his stables with four
head of horses, a quantity of fodder and shucks

These are therefore to require you forthwith to ar-
rest the said Catharine & bring her before me or the
next Magistrate of said District at the said David
Lipscomb's on the first day of February by 10 o'clock
A.M. to be dealt with according to law
