We would respectfully present for your  
consideration the case of L. G. Holloway who  
is fifty seven years of age he has on his  
plantation about twenty hands there is no  
other male adult on the place, he also  
has the management of his sisters (Cla-  
rissa Holloways) plantation on which there  
is no white male on which there is also  
some dozen hands on both of these plan-  
tations the farming interest will be great-  
ly neglected in the absence of the S. L. G.  
Holloway We the undersigned who live in  
the immediate neighborhood of the parties  
therefore petition your Excellency to grant  
a detail to Mr. Holloway that he may  
not be subject to the late military call
