

Memorandum 25 Feb 1865

Major J. B. White  
Commander, Kate Cadets

Major.

In consequence of not receiving any intelligence of our progress, I fear you have left the Kate. If so, it was improper to have done so, without explicit orders from me. The departure of that of the other Kate took, equally unauthorised, has left the Kate dependent; with its ~~board~~ by itself, seriously threatened.

You will now immediately upon the receipt of this letter, be detached from the main-body of the army; & dividing yourself with the enemy, proceed by the most expeditious & safest line of march, to this place, where you will report & there await further orders.
