

Unionville. 25 Feb'y 1885

My dear Sir

I am about to start for Spartan-
burg where I will remain for two or three
days collecting & organizing what force I can
to meet an anticipated raid under the
direction of Genl. Stoneham of which I have
just received information.

In a short time a Courier line
will be established to Yorkville & I will
rely upon you to continue the line to
Charlote. During the interruption of these
Communications, you can send all
Communications thro' the line of the
Courier. Spartanburg will probably be
my head quarters & you will send your
Communications there until Messers
arrive.

I hope the children have not put
you to any inconvenience: how can I
easily express the extent of the obligations
which your kindness has imposed upon me.
