

Edgefield C.H. Feb 18. 1865 -

To His Excellency A. G. Magraw

Your petitioner M. Frazer wishes an exemption from the late Militia call on the following reasons first I am in very bad health & have been for years so much so I have on now occasion been able to be out at night or able to stand on my feet more than half an hour at any one time I am all most 59 years old have but one son he has been in the war from the beginning was not quite 18 years old I have no white person on my place but a wife & daughter 16 years old I have 46 Negroes on my place & now one to look to but my self I was exempt one one ocasion from all health serving in the Militia
